

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 146

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-115 WITH LEBIS ENTERPRISES, INC. TO PROVIDE DEMOLITION OF THE FORMER FREEDOM CHURCH, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,308.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, demolition of the Former Freedom Church building is necessary to complete site preparation for the Windermere Headstart facilities; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Lebis Enterprises, Inc. for Project 9.43, Windermere Headstart Demolition, Phase III, Former Freedom Church was received on October 8, 2001, in the amount of \$42,308.00; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Lebis Enterprises, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Lebis Enterprises, Inc. for Project 9.43, Windermere Headstart Demolition, Phase III Former Freedom Church be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lebis Enterprises, Inc. for Project 9.43, Windermere Headstart Demolition Phase III, Former Freedom Church.

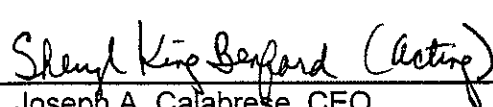
Section 3. That said contract shall be in the amount of forty two thousand three hundred eight and 00/100 dollars (\$42,308.00) payable out of the RTA Development Fund, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-03-0150 (\$33,846.00 in Federal Funds, which represents 80% of the total cost).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
