

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 149

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2001-091 WITH MUNCIE RECLAMATION & SUPPLY INC. dba MUNCIE TRANSIT SUPPLY, FOR THE FURNISHING OF NON ASBESTOS BOLT ON BRAKE BLOCKS AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$43,165.02 – GENERAL FUND (INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Muncie Reclamation & Supply dba Muncie Transit Supply, located at 3720 South Madison Street , Muncie, IN 47302, for the furnishing of non asbestos bolt on brake blocks as required for a period of one year was received on September 18, 2001, at unit prices resulting in a total price not to exceed \$43,165.02; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Muncie Reclamation & Supply dba Muncie Transit Supply, to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Muncie Reclamation & Supply dba Muncie Transit Supply, for non asbestos bolt on brake blocks as required for a period of one year, at the unit price specified, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Muncie Reclamation & Supply Inc. dba Muncie Transit Supply, for non asbestos bolt on brake block as required for a period of one year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) at a price not to exceed forty three thousand one hundred sixty five & 02/100 dollars (\$43,165.02).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064 bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
