AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-102 WITH SCHIRMER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY TO REMOVE AND REPLACE EXISTING CONCRETE SIDEWALKS AT THE CEDAR/UNIVERSITY STATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$138,827.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, in accordance with ADA requirements sidewalks will be removed and replaced at the Cedar/University Red Line Station; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Schirmer Construction Company, 31350 Industrial Parkway, North Olmsted, Ohio 44070, for Project 24K1(B) Cedar/University ADA Sidewalk/Curb Ramps, was received on September 25, 2001, in the amount of \$138,827; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Schirmer Construction Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Schirmer Construction Company for Project 24K1(B), Cedar/University ADA Sidewalk/Curb Ramps be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Schirmer Construction Company, for Project 24K1(B), Cedar/University ADA Sidewalk/Curb Ramps.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Development Fund, including but not limited to Capital Grant OH-03-0186 (\$111,061.60 in Federal Funds, which represents 80% of the total cost) in the amount of one hundred thirty eight thousand eight hundred twenty seven & 60/100 dollars (\$138,827.00)

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
