On Sunday, the 20th of April, 2025, I (Officer [REDACTED] of the Bratenahl Police Department) was off-duty, travelling to work in my personal vehicle when a traffic stop was conducted by a Transit Police Vehicle. The female officer approached my vehicle and I asked why I had been stopped. The female officer advised that she felt I was going a little too fast. I inquired about Transit Police jurisdiction and if traffic stops were permitted on the interstate. The officer advised me that yes Transit Police does have county wide jurisdiction to make traffic stops. I offered to provide my driver's licens and police identification and the officer said no and immediately returned to her vehicle. The officer did not identify herself, but I observed her name plate said [REDACTED] I did not observe any other officers on scene or outside the vehicle at the time of the stop.

I hereby state under penalty of Perjury (Revised Code 2921.11) that I am the complainant in this complaint, that I have prepared, read, and fully understand all matters set forth in this complaint, that this may result in an official investigation, and the information provided is true and complete to my knowledge.

I understand that filing a false report of misconduct against a Peace Officer is in violation of section 2921.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, a misdemeanor of the first degree.

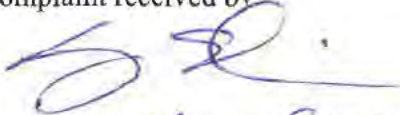
