EXISTING WHEELCHAIR LIFTS







WHY RAMPS?

- Lifts are costly to maintain, frequent breakdowns and hard to keep clean.
- Existing lifts do not accommodate oversized wheelchairs.



OVERSIZED WHEELCHAIR IN THE EXISTING LIFT

NEW ADA RAMPS

- Cast-in place concrete.
- Thermoplastic guard and handrails.
- Prefinished aluminum shelters.
- Low maintenance.
