

Bus Stop Consolidation/Safety Improvement

- Upgrade bus stops to new design
 - o Route number
 - Destination
 - Days/hours of service
 - Stop ID number
- Consolidate nearby stops to provide faster service to residents and businesses on the route
- Improve safety of bus stops throughout RTA network

 weekday to Diamond Parkway in Glenwillow


Fall Service Change Effective August 12, 2018


Fall Service Change – August 12

- Added school trips and run time/trip adjustments
- New timetables for: Red Line, 3, 8, 9, 11, 16, 22, 26, 41/41F, 45, 49, 51/A/B/C (MetroHealth Line), 55/A/B/C (Cleveland State Line), 75, 79/79A, 83, 86
- #3 widened Saturday headway from :20 to :30 improve connections
- #9 widened Saturday headway from :45 to :60
 before 8:00 am

Potential Future Service Change Ideas

Improve Reliability on #76

- #76 experiencing schedule delays due to increased freight railroad traffic near the Broadway/W. Grace intersection
- Railroad traffic is planned to further increase
- Potential change would improve reliability of #76 for riders and provide a faster, more direct route to Southgate Transit Center
- #40 would be modified to serve portions of the current
 #76



#15, #19 Eastern Area – One Option










#14 & #15 to use Superior Bus Lanes?

- Origin & Destination Survey data indicated that many riders would be better served by the proposed route
- Average travel time is similar on both alternatives
- Travel time via Superior is much more reliable
- Prospect subject to larger delay fluctuations due to special events downtown



#14/#15 Downtown Alternatives







#77F & #90F Downtown Alternatives
