Background:

- RTA is mandated to provide Complementary
 Paratransit Service to eligible clients
- Annual ridership has averaged over 650,000 passengers for the past five years
- All requested trips must be scheduled
 - Zero denials over 7.5 M requests since last denial



Background (cont'd.):

- On average, 1,581 trips per day are completed
 - o RTA: 700
 - o Contractors: 881
- RTA must maintain current service expectations and acceptable on-time performance



Background (cont'd.):

- BOT members have expressed concerns related to current quality of service, contractor oversight, performance, employee appearance, training, and vehicle condition
- RFP timing was modified to enhance competition and address these concerns
- New RFP was designed to emphasize high quality service at affordable costs



Scope of Work Requirements in New RFP:

- Safe, reliable, clean, and courteous transportation
- Professional drivers with professional appearance and sensitivity to client needs
- Clean and well maintained vehicles with vehicle age 0 - 5 years



Scope of Work Requirements (cont'd)

- Technology improvements include tablets for navigation and direct in-vehicle communications with GCRTA dispatch center
- Comprehensive training and complaint resolution program for contractors and subcontractors
- Liquidated damages will be assessed for service failures



- RFP issued August 2018
- Accessed on the GCRTA website by forty (40) interested parties
- Nine (9) firms proposed and all were selected for interviews



Evaluation Panel Members:

- EEO and ADA
- Legal
- Office of Business Development
- o Paratransit
- Procurement



Evaluation Criteria:

- Responsiveness to stated objectives and scope of services
- Experience in successful operation of similar projects
- Qualifications of proposing firms
- Qualifications of assigned personnel
- Cost effectiveness



- The strategy was to align all contracts, allowing the potential for large national vendors to compete
- The strategy increased competition which provided higher commitment to quality and lower overall pricing
- It became evident that splitting the award among three responsible proposers would be in the best interest of the Authority
- This preserves internal competition and capacity assurance, which are two key components to the reliability of our contracted paratransit services



Three recommended firms:

- Future Age, Inc. dba Provide A Ride 60%
 - Equivalent to 128,843 hours in first year
- GC Logistics of Mississippi, LLC 30%
 - Equivalent to 64,422 hours in first year
- Senior Transportation Connection 10%
 - Equivalent to 21,474 hours in first year

Total first year hours: 214,739
