

Light Rail Bonding Renewal What are Bonds?

- Provide electrical continuity between sections of rail
- Provide both signal information and traction power return
- Without bonds the signal system does not function properly





- Trunk Line Between East 79th Street Station and Shaker Square
- o Green and Blue Lines from Shaker Square
- Work will be done on Active Track with flagging protection


- o C-Bonds / Rail joint bonds: 11

- o Invitation For Bid (IFB) issued January 14, 2019
- Accessed on the GCRTA web site by sixteen (16) interested parties
- o One (1) firm submitted a bid



- o Recommended Vendor:
 - o Hatzel & Buehler, Inc.'s bid of \$265,000.00 was determined to be the lowest responsive bid and is 2.3% below the Independent Cost Estimate of \$271,280.50.
 - Responsibility determination is in progress.
 - A 17% DBE goal was assigned and will be achieved utilizing Denise's Flagging Services.
