











# Summary of Proposed Award Fiber Optic Communications System **Improvements**

### **Current Fiber Optic Network:**

- Consists of several different generations of equipment and fiber optic cable
- The fiber optic network provides communications transport services to many departments such as Operations, IT, Transit Police, Emergency Call Boxes, and Asset Configuration

### **Current Fiber Optic Network:**

- Mission critical for several GCRTA Departments
  - Safety Fire Alarm Panel communications
  - Security Cameras, 911 call boxes
  - CTDS Consolidated Train Dispatch System
  - SCADA Supervisory Control & Data Acquisition



### **Current Fiber Optic Network:**

- Most of the fiber optic equipment has been in service since 1992 and is at the end of its life
- Many components of the system have been discontinued and are no longer supported
- Overhead fiber optic cable is severely deteriorated



#### **Deliverables:**

- New 10 GB Backbone Fiber Optic Network to be installed
- Existing 18 strand cable to be replaced with 96 strand cable, reducing the Authority's reliance on leased lines
- New Ethernet based Communications Network Equipment to be installed
- Provide communication transport services from Windermere to Airport

- Invitation for Bid (IFB) issued November 4, 2019
- Accessed on the GCRTA web site by forty-five (45) interested parties
- Two (2) firms submitted a bid
