- Contract approximate five-year duration.

- Perform Car Build Specification Conformance
- Identify Additional S/SC Test Requirements



Ten phases (Final Five):

- Perform Testing and Validation to Support S/SC Program
- Manage Integrated Tests for the S/SC Program
- Manage Open Items in the S/SC Program
- Verify Operational Readiness
- Conduct Final Readiness Determination –
 Issue Safety & Security Certification
