

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – September 2021

Summary

- The COVID-19 pandemic continued to affect ridership
- System ridership in September 2021 was 1.5 million, representing 25% more riders than in September 2020
 - Average fixed route weekday was 22% higher¹
 - Average fixed route Saturday was 7% higher¹
 - Average fixed route Sunday was 21% higher¹



<u> Motorbus (MB)</u>

Motorbus ridership in September 2021 was 33% higher than in September 2020

- Average weekday was 30% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 13% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 20% lower¹



Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in September 2021 was 20% higher than in September 2020

- Average weekday was 13% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 7% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 45% higher¹



<u>Light Rail (LR)</u>

Blue and Green Line services were shut down for maintenance on August 8th, 2021 and did not resume until October. Year-over-year comparisons between September 2020 and September 2021 light rail ridership counts are affected by this service irregularity



HealthLine (RB)


HealthLine ridership in September 2021 was 20% higher than in September 2020


- Average weekday was 16% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 8% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 25% higher¹




Paratransit (DR)


Paratransit ridership in August 2021 was 31% higher than in August 2020







System Ridership by Month
