

# Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – June 2023

#### **Summary**

- Ridership continued to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting shutdowns
- System ridership in June 2023 was 1.8 million, representing 13% more riders than in June 2022
  - Average fixed route weekday was 12% higher¹
  - o Average fixed route Saturday was 15% higher<sup>1</sup>
  - o Average fixed route Sunday was 15% higher<sup>1</sup>



## Bus (MB)

Bus ridership in June 2023 was 15% higher than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 15% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 16% higher<sup>1</sup>
- Average Sunday was 17% higher¹



### Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in June 2023 was 15% higher than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 12% higher<sup>1</sup>
- Average Saturday was 30% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 22% higher<sup>1</sup>



### **Light Rail (LR)**

Light Rail ridership in June 2023 was 17% lower than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 19% lower<sup>1</sup>
- Average Saturday was 2% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 24% lower<sup>1</sup>



## **HealthLine (RB)**


HealthLine ridership in June 2023 was 1% higher than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 1% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 5% lower<sup>1</sup>
- Average Sunday was 9% higher¹





## Paratransit (DR)


Paratransit ridership in June 2023 was 15% higher than in June 2022
