

# Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report – July 2023

#### **Summary**

- System ridership in July 2023 was 1.7 million, representing 17% more riders than in July 2022
  - o Average fixed route weekday was 20% higher<sup>1</sup>
  - o Average fixed route Saturday was 22% lower<sup>1</sup>
  - o Average fixed route Sunday was 43% higher<sup>1</sup>



#### Bus (MB)

Bus ridership in July 2023 was 15% higher than in July 2022

- Average weekday was 19% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 35% lower<sup>1</sup>
- Average Sunday was 48% higher<sup>1</sup>



## **Red Line (HR)**

Red Line ridership in July 2023 was 20% higher than in July 2022

- Average weekday was 22% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 13% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 19% higher<sup>1</sup>



## **Light Rail (LR)**

Light Rail ridership in July 2023 was 27% higher than in July 2022

- Average weekday was 40% higher<sup>1</sup>
- Average Saturday was 30% lower<sup>1</sup>
- Average Sunday was 21% lower<sup>1</sup>



# **HealthLine (RB)**

HealthLine ridership in July 2023 was 18% higher than in July 2022


- Average weekday was 14% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 1% lower<sup>1</sup>
- Average Sunday was 92% higher<sup>1</sup>




#### Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in July 2023 was 12% higher than in July 2022


## System Ridership by Month




### August Avg. Ridership by Day Type
