

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report, September 2023



Summary

- Total ridership in September 2023 was 1.97M, which is an 11% increase from September 2022
 - Avg. fixed-route weekday increased 10%
 - Avg. fixed-route Saturday increased 2%
 - Avg. fixed-route Sunday increased 70%

Bus (MB)

- Bus ridership in September 2023 was 1.48M, which is a 16% increase from September 2022
 - Average weekday increased 17%
 - Average Saturday decreased 2%
 - Average Sunday increased 75%

Red Line/Heavy Rail (HR)

- Red Line ridership in September 2023 was 281K, which is a 14% increase from September 2022
 - Average weekday increased 12%
 - Average Saturday increased 11%
 - Average Sunday increased 37%

HealthLine (RB)

- HealthLine ridership in Sept. 2023 was 152K, which is a 9% increase from September 2022
 - Average weekday stayed consistent (0%)
 - Average Saturday increased 51%
 - Average Sunday increased 79%


Light Rail (LR)

- Light Rail ridership in September 2023 was 8K, which is an 88% decrease from September 2022
- Waterfront Line was the only Light Rail service active due to Blue Line & Green Line shutdowns


Paratransit (DR)

- Paratransit ridership in Sept. 2023 was 50K, which is an 11% increase from September 2022


Total Ridership by Month




Avg. Ridership by Day Type
