Ridership Report, December 2023



Summary

- Total ridership in December 2023 was 1.83M, which is a 16% increase from December 2022
 - Avg. fixed-route weekday increased 21%
 - Avg. fixed-route Saturday increased 6%
 - Avg. fixed-route Sunday decreased 39%*

Bus (MB)

- Bus ridership in December 2023 was 1.28M, which is a 14% increase from December 2022
 - Average weekday increased 18%
 - Average Saturday increased 12%
 - Average Sunday decreased 17%

Red Line/Heavy Rail (HR)

- Red Line ridership in December 2023 was 305K, which is a 25% increase from December 2022
 - Average weekday increased 30%
 - Average Saturday increased 33%
 - Average Sunday increased 19%

HealthLine (RB)

- HealthLine ridership in Dec. 2023 was 128K, which is an 8% increase from December 2022
 - Average weekday increased 6%
 - Average Saturday increased 22%
 - Average Sunday increased 10%

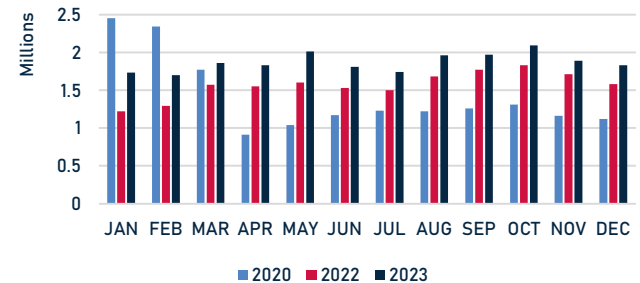
Light Rail (LR)

- Light Rail ridership in December 2023 was 66K, which is a 22% increase from December 2022
 - Average weekday increased 35%
 - Average Saturday decreased 13%
 - Average Sunday increased 5%

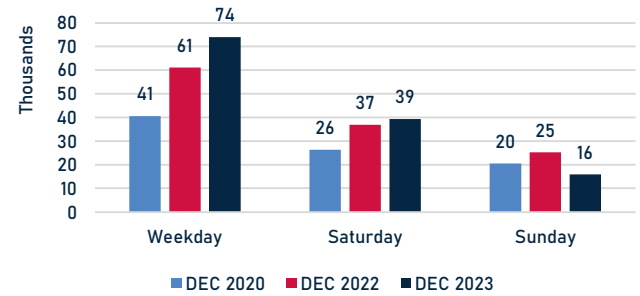
Paratransit (DR)

- Paratransit ridership in Dec. 2023 was 52K, which is a 16% increase from December 2022

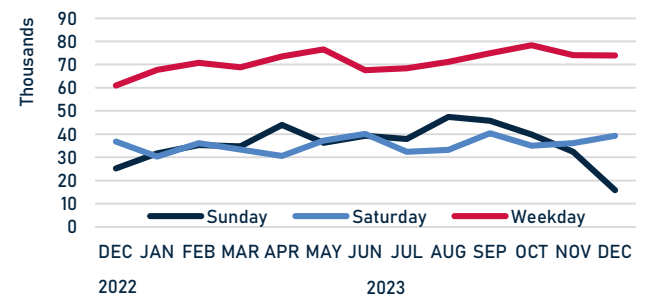
Total Ridership by Month



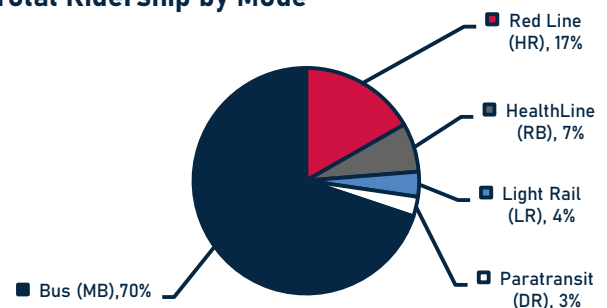
Avg. Ridership by Day Type
