Railcar Replacement Purchase

- Railcar Replacement Purchase (Siemens Mobility Inc.)
 - Base contract (24 vehicles) (4-18-23)
 - Exercised Option 1 (6 vehicles) (11-28-23)
- Current Contract Value \$194,429,019.00








High Floor Light Rail Vehicles

II. Exterior Design Concept

Siemens Mobility, Rolling Stock I Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority



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Key Features of New Vehicle

- First High floor LRV built to RT1-2020 design standards
- Ice cutter pantograph on every train
- Heated windshield and pantograph
- Load leveling system to adjust floor height
- Dedicated HVAC unit for operator cab
- 52 passenger seats, 4 wheelchair areas and 2 bicycle racks
- Passenger Information System



Design & Construction Support Services

- Vehicle Engineering Firm Hatch
 - Developed railcar RFP
 - Design review and manufacturing oversight
- Safety & Security Certification
 - K & J Safety and Security Consulting Services
- Infrastructure Modifications
 - Track work design utilize existing on-call contract with Parsons
 - New RFPs for facility modifications
 - Construction support services will be performed by GCRTA staff

Infrastructure Modifications

- Brookpark Rail Shop
 - Track work Parsons (Design) Expected Completion (3-1-24)*
 - Track work Advertise Construction Bid Package (3-18-24)*
 - Building Interior Parsons (Design) Issue NTP (February 2024)*
- Central Rail Maintenance Facility
 - Building Interior Advertise Design Proposal (March 2024)*
 - Construction Advertise Bid Package (March 2025)

Infrastructure Modifications (Con't)

- Port of Cleveland Track Connection
 - Parsons (Design) Complete
 - Environmental Process Under FTA review
 - » Temporary and Permanent Easements*
 - Construction IFB Issued 1-15-24
 - » Construction Bids due 2-15-24*

Infrastructure Modifications (Con't)

- Platform Modifications
 - Red Line Design Issue RFP (March 2024)*
 - Blue/Green/Waterfront Lines TBD

Other coordination activities

- Employee Training
 - Developing strategy to train mechanics
 - Hiring 2 additional mechanic trainers to assist
 - Leveraging knowledge from other transit properties
- Operational Considerations
 - Testing, construction, revenue service implementation and final configuration
