Ridership Report, February 2024



Summary

- Total ridership in February 2024 was 1.92M, which is a 13% increase from February 2023
 - Avg. fixed-route weekday increased 8%
 - Avg. fixed-route Saturday increased 21%
 - Avg. fixed-route Sunday decreased 1%

Bus (MB)

- Bus ridership in February 2024 was 1.36M, which is a 15% increase from February 2023
 - Average weekday increased 9%
 - Average Saturday increased 33%
 - Average Sunday increased 2%

Red Line/Heavy Rail (HR)

- Red Line ridership in February 2024 was 264K, which is a 5% decrease from February 2023
 - Average weekday decreased 9%
 - Average Saturday decreased 11%
 - Average Sunday decreased 4%

HealthLine (RB)

- HealthLine ridership in February 2024 was 165K, which is a 26% increase from February 2023
 - Average weekday increased 26%
 - Average Saturday increased 22%
 - Average Sunday decreased 14%

Light Rail (LR)

- Light Rail ridership in February 2024 was 80K, which is a 40% increase from February 2023
 - Average weekday increased 36%
 - Average Saturday increased 14%
 - Average Sunday increased 8%

Paratransit (DR)

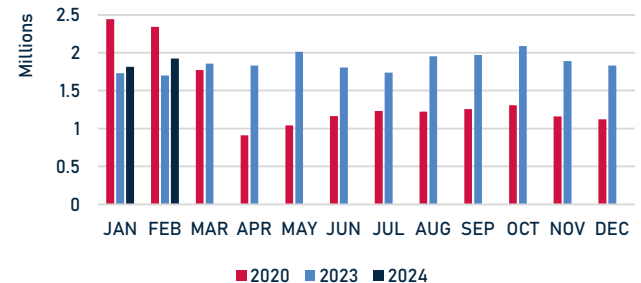
- Paratransit ridership in February 2024 was 54K, which is a 17% increase from February 2023

Note: Average ridership by day type does not include atypical days as defined by the Federal Transit Administration for National Transit Database reporting.

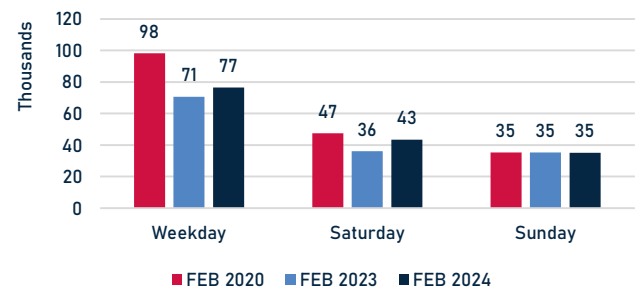
¹Due to new bus ridership sourcing methods, average weekend day comparisons in 2024 may vary when compared to previous years.

²Fixed-Route "typical" Sundays in December 2023 only included Christmas Eve, Christmas, and New Year's Eve.

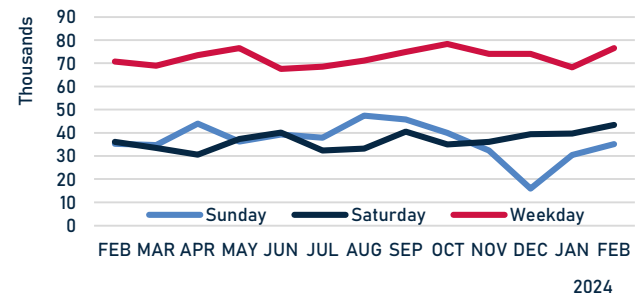
Total Ridership by Month
