SUMMARY OF PROPOSED AWARD SHOP UNIFORM RENTAL AND MAINTENANCE

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Authority provides Shop Uniform Rental and Maintenance for both bargaining and non-bargaining employees based on job description. Each employee receives 11 sets of uniforms (pants and shirts), of which 5 sets are laundered and maintained weekly.

The Authority has a current contract with Cintas Corporation, which has been successfully delivering shop uniform rental and maintenance services to both bargaining and non-bargaining employees.

PROCUREMENT OVERVIEW:

R.C. Section 306.43(H)(4) provides political subdivisions within the State of Ohio the opportunity to participate in contracts negotiated and executed by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Cooperative Purchasing Program.

The State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program includes a contract with Cintas Corporation under State Term Contract No. RS900118. This contract is a result of a competitive solicitation.

Cintas Corporation, a Fortune 500 company, serves over one million businesses of various sizes and industries. Their diverse customer base includes small manufacturing firms, mid-sized hotel chains, and major corporations. Approximately 70% of Cintas' clients are in the service sector, while the remaining 30% are in goods-producing industries.

CLIENT BASE

Cintas holds 28 state contracts, including those with the States of Ohio and Michigan. Notable in-state clients include Cuyahoga County, the City of Cleveland, Cleveland Area Metro Parks, the City of Akron, the City of Columbus, the City of Cincinnati, the City of Dayton, Lucas County, Mahoning County, Hamilton County, Franklin County, Summit County, Dayton RTA, SORTA (Cincinnati area public transit), COTA (Columbus Transit), TARTA (Toledo Area Transit), North East Ohio Regional Sewer District, Cincinnati Metro Sewer District, Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, CVG Airport (Cincinnati), John Glenn International Airport (Columbus), Dayton International Airport, and Toledo International Airport.

RECOMMENDATION

The committee recommends Cintas Corporation, with an office at 6800 Cintas Boulevard, Mason, OH 45040, to provide Shop Uniform Rental and Maintenance Services.

A resolution will request authorization to issue a contract to Cintas Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$941,941.46 for a base period of three years, and in amounts not to exceed \$331,399.73 and \$342,335.92 for each of two option years, respectively, for a total five-year contract amount not to exceed \$1,615,677.11.

SUMMARY OF AWARD Procurement of a Line Car

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Authority has the need to purchase a new line car. The current rail line car (PWR-032) is the primary vehicle used by the Power & Way department to maintain the overhead contact system. This Tokyu Line Car, built in 1977, has served the Authority well, but its age and declining performance have begun to impact operations, safety, and overall efficiency. In addition, the current line car will not fit the reduced clearance Wayside after the new railcars are in service.

PROCUREMENT OVERVIEW:

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") for the Procurement of a Line Car was issued on May 6, 2024. The necessary legal notice was published in the <u>Plain Dealer</u> and <u>Call & Post</u> newspapers. The Invitation for Bid was also published on the RTA web site.

The Invitation for Bid ("IFB") was accessed and/or downloaded from the web site by six (6) interested parties. Two bids were received and opened on June 21, 2024. The responsive bids were as follows:

Company Name	Total Base Bid
Geismar North America, Inc.	\$5,165,257.00
Plasser American Corp.	\$5,233,817.60

The Basis of Award is the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for the Total Base Bid price. Geismar North America, Inc. was determined to be a responsive bidder.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Office of Business Development has set a 0% DBE participation goal for this project.

Geismar North America, Inc. has been in existence since 1974 under the name Modern Track Machinery, Inc. In 2018, the company changed its name to Geismar North America. Inc.

Geismar North America, Inc. is currently building a locomotive for GCRTA.

A resolution will request authorization to issue a contract to Geismar North America, Inc. for the Procurement of a Line Car in an amount not to exceed \$5,165,257.00. This bid is 25.34% above the estimate of \$4,120,988.00.
