

# Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority

## Ridership Report, October 2024



### Summary

- Total ridership in October 2024 was 2.3M, which is a 14% increase compared to October 2023
  - Avg. fixed-route weekday increased 11%
  - Avg. fixed-route weekend increased 33%

### Motor Bus (MB)

- Bus ridership in October 2024 was 1.7M, which is a 14% increase compared to October 2023
  - Average weekday increased 10%
  - Average weekend increased 37%

### Red Line/Heavy Rail (HR)

- Red Line ridership in October 2024 was 292K, which is a 11% increase compared to Oct. 2023
  - Average weekday increased 8%
  - Average weekend increased 16%

### HealthLine/Bus Rapid Transit (RB)

- HealthLine ridership in October 2024 was 199K, which is a 26% increase compared to Oct. 2023
  - Average weekday increased 26%
  - Average weekend increased 47%

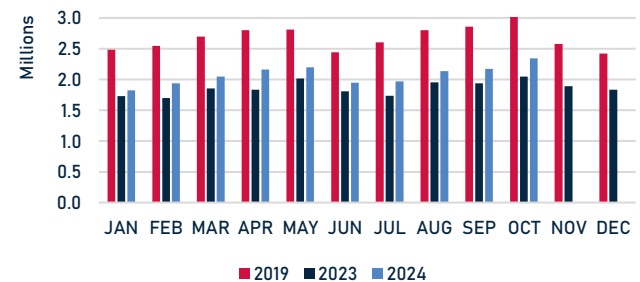
### Light Rail (LR)

- Light Rail ridership in October 2024 was 75K, which is a 14% increase compared Oct. 2023
  - Average weekday increased 4%
  - Average weekend increased 22%

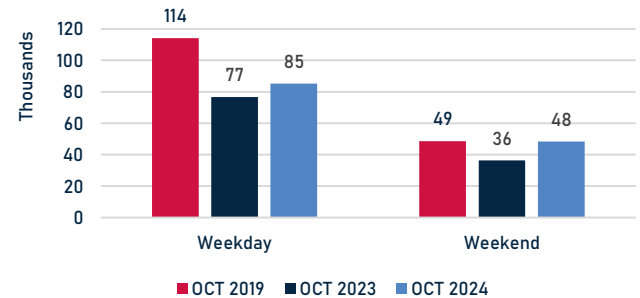
### Paratransit (DR)

- Paratransit ridership in October 2024 was 62K, which is a 14% increase compared to Oct. 2023

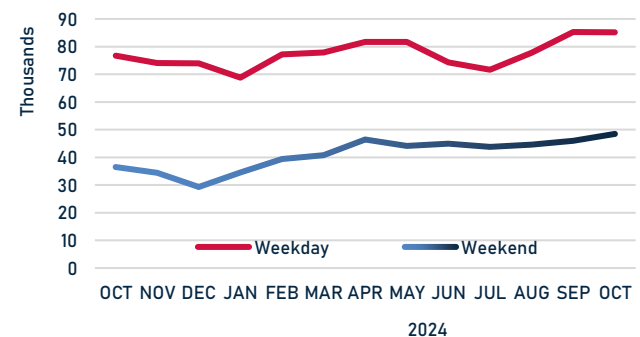
### Total Ridership by Month



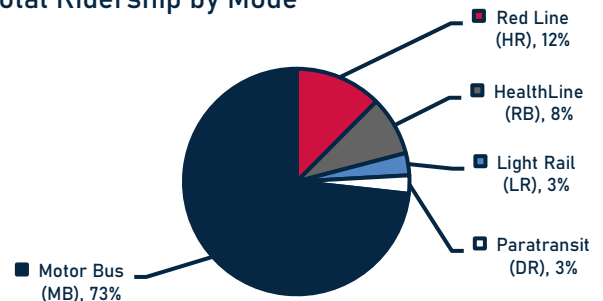
### Avg. Daily Ridership by Day Type

Due to new bus ridership sourcing methods, average weekend days in 2024 may appear to show large variations when compared to previous years. The old sourcing method was not as precise in apportioning ridership to weekends.
