

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Ridership Report, November 2024



Summary

- Total ridership in November 2024 was 2.1M, which is a 13% increase compared to Nov. 2023
 - Avg. fixed-route weekday increased 13%
 - Avg. fixed-route weekend increased 30%

Motor Bus (MB)

- Bus ridership in November 2024 was 1.5M, which is a 15% increase compared to Nov. 2023
 - Average weekday increased 15%
 - Average weekend increased 44%

Red Line/Heavy Rail (HR)

- Red Line ridership in November 2024 was 269K, which is a 4% increase compared to Nov. 2023
 - Average weekday increased 6%
 - Average weekend increased 3%

HealthLine/Bus Rapid Transit (RB)

- HealthLine ridership in Nov. 2024 was 169K, which is a 20% increase compared to Nov. 2023
 - Average weekday increased 24%
 - Average weekend increased 15%

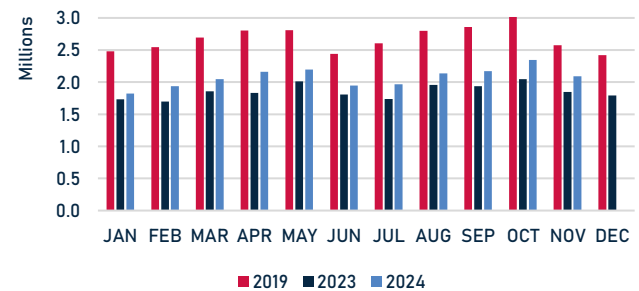
Light Rail (LR)

- Light Rail ridership in November 2024 was 65K, which is a 4% increase compared Nov. 2023
 - Average weekday increased 3%
 - Average weekend increased 15%

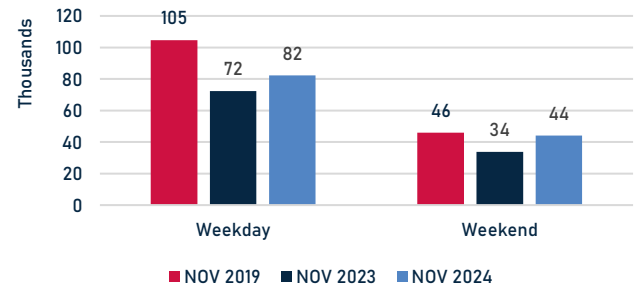
Paratransit (DR)

- Paratransit ridership in Nov. 2024 was 56K, which is an 11% increase compared to Nov. 2023

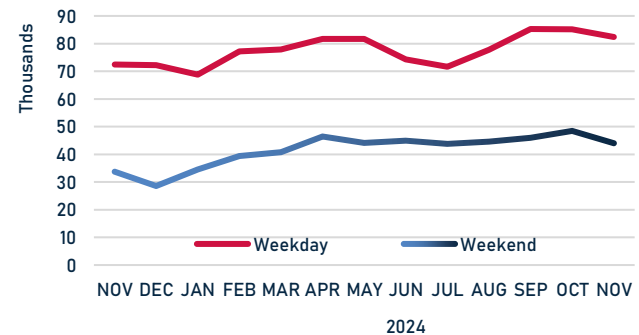
Total Ridership by Month



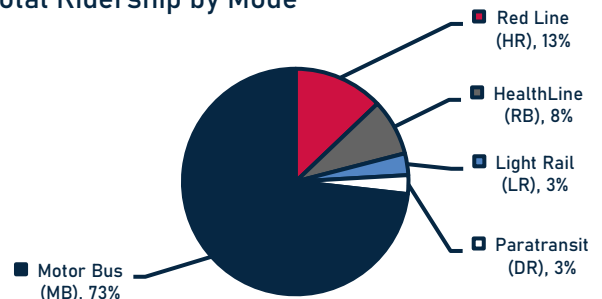
Avg. Daily Ridership by Day Type

Due to new bus ridership sourcing methods, average weekend days in 2024 may appear to show large variations when compared to previous years. The old sourcing method was not as precise in apportioning ridership to weekends.
