Replacement criteria

- Software – Demands on Hardware
- Supportability – Patching (Security)
- Warranty – Expensive with Older Equipment
- Life Cycle 3 Years (Recycled)

Computers State of Good Repair

Justification

- Approximately 300 units that will not support newer Microsoft security patches
- Many units beyond 3-year life cycle
- Out of warranty
- Standardization replacing HP with Lenovo
