Memorandum of Understanding Between the

Amalgamated Transit Union &
The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority

SERVICE QUALITY SUPERVISOR III – GRADE 636

Effective upon execution, this memorandum of understanding will confirm the bargaining issues surrounding the Authority's creation of a bus/rail cross-trained Service Quality Supervisor. The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and the Amalgamated Transit Union, having met and conferred, agree to the wages, hours and conditions of employment outlined herein. Except as outlined in this agreement, no other terms and conditions shall be provided for in the Collective Bargaining Agreement still in effect between the GCRTA and the ATU effective August 1, 2006 through July 31, 2009.

- The cross-trained Grade 6 Service Quality Supervisor, Service Quality Supervisor III – Grade 636, wage rate will remain the same as the current Grade 6 Service Quality Supervisors.
- 2. Any employee currently working in the Grade 634 position may continue to work in that classification. Any current Grade 634 employee may also voluntarily train and be reclassified as a Grade 636 Service Quality Supervisor III.
- 3. Picking of shifts will be based on grade seniority and not classification seniority.

The GCRTA and the ATU acknowledge that they have had ample opportunity to confer and bargain over all negotiable matters affecting wages, hours and, terms and conditions of employment for this Service Quality Supervisor III – Grade 636 position. This agreement represents a complete and final understanding between the GCRTA and the ATU on all bargaining issues regarding the Service Quality Supervisor III – Grade 636 position.
