2014 - 18 CIP BUDGET DEVELOPMENT

- Completed CIP Development Process Earlier to Better Align TIP/STIP Process With Federal Fiscal Year
- Continued to Align CIP Budget with Anticipated Funding
- Maintains Focus on State of Good Repair Projects
- Continues Reduced Levels of Preventive Maintenance (PM) Reimbursements to the Operating Budget and Redirects Formula Grant Funds to Address Needed Capital Projects

2014-18 CIP ISSUES & CHALLENGES

- Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21)
 - Reduced Formula Funding for the GCRTA
 - Short-Term Program Up for Renewal within Two Years
 - Eliminates Bus Discretionary Grants & Future Funding for JARC/Work Access Program
 - Primary Focus is on State of Good Repair (SGR) Projects
 - Establishes Transit Asset Management Requirements and New Standards for Capital Assets

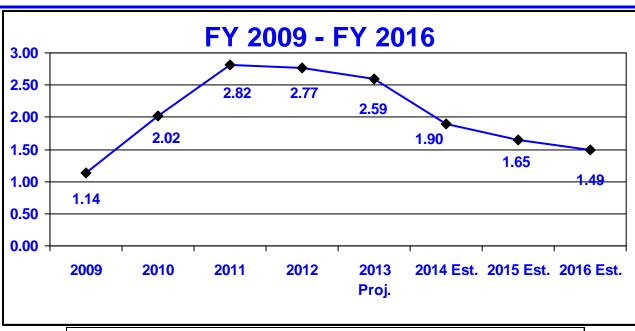


2014-18 CIP ISSUES & CHALLENGES

- Identify Funding for the Purchase of
 - 23 Articulated Buses and 35 40' Buses with Delivery in 2014;
 - Average of 35 40' Buses/Year with Deliveries Between 2015 and 2020;
 - 60 Paratransit Buses Delivered in 2016 Through 2019; and
 - 17 Trolley Buses Delivered in 2016 Through 2018
- Declining Debt Service Ratio Due to Lower Projected Balances in the General Fund (GF)
 - Resources Redirected to Capital Program
 - Still Exceeds Board Established Measure
 - Continue Focus on Improving GF Balance
