### Harvard Garage Facts



- Address: 2501 Harvard Avenue, Newburgh Hts
  - 193,175 square foot, 18.46 acres
  - Built in 1995
  - Closed for service in 2010
- Marketed in 2011
- Currently for training & equipment storage







### Cuyahoga County History at Harvard

- Short-term License by County in January 2013
  - 11,250 sq. ft.
  - Use as storage space
  - \$2,343.75/ month
  - 6 months
  - Limited access
- Real Estate Policies require Board Approval of Project agreements OVER \$25,000/yr.




### **Cuyahoga County Proposal**

- Requires immediate access to accommodate construction/consolidation of new facilities
- Through December 2014 and maybe continuing.
- Square footage to increase to approx. 63,650 sq ft. (33% of building)
- Daily access to building
- Market rate rent estimated between \$13,125-\$15,000/month
  - Portion of utilities
  - Portion of insurance
  - Snowplowing
