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# Paratransit Repair Facility

- Preventative maintenance for 300 vehicles is performed at Facility
  - Paratransit Buses
  - Police Cars
  - Support Vehicles
- A parts inventory is required to support these activities





## **Project Overview**

- A 2008 study concluded the RTA could benefit from contracting material mgt. services and inventory parts
- Contract awarded 2008 for five (5) years for a total of \$2,770,000
- Contract commenced operation in December 2009 and expires November 2014



## Lessons Learned

- Reduced inventory investment
  - Pay for parts when installed
- Eliminated purchase of parts that may become obsolete
  - Do not own parts on shelves
- Increased Parts Availability at Reduced Cost
  - Large National supply chain
- Increased Shop Productivity



### Issue

 Due to aging fleet, actual number of replacement parts exceeded initial projections.



## **Contract Status**

- Contract awarded 2008 for five (5) years for a total of \$2,770,000
- Change Orders to date to increase funding for parts totaling \$250,000
- Additional funds needed for parts for duration of contact term



## Recommendation

Approve change order for \$420,000.00 for parts needed thru November 2014

- Request has been approved by Change-Order Committee
- Funding was included and approved in 2014 budget
