# **Electric Procurement**

Presented to: Finance Committee January 21, 2014



- Electricity major component of budget
  - 2014 budget \$5,655,000
    - Rail 59% (\$3.3M)
    - Non Rail 41% (\$2.3M)



- Current Electrical Contracts
  - FirstEnergy Solutions (CEI)
    - Expires 05/31/14
      - 88% of Budget, 91% of kWh Usage
  - Cleveland Public Power
    - Expires 01/07/15
      - I2% of Budget, 9% of kWh Usage



#### History

- Prior to deregulation Electricity sole sourced from Utility
- June 2009 Ohio's Electric market was opened for competition
  - Distribution Utility
  - Electricity Utility or Supplier



- Since deregulation, 2 Electricity RFPs have been issued
  - November 30<sup>th</sup> 2009
    - T8 month FirstEnergy Solutions
    - Price per kWh decreased from \$.069 to \$.053



- Since deregulation, 2 Electricity RFPs have been issued – continued
  - March 7<sup>th</sup> 2011
    - ~3 year FirstEnergy Solutions
    - Price per kWh decreased from \$.053 to \$.049



- Total Electrical Expenses
  - 2009 \$8,146,000

#### Savings vs 2009

- 2010 \$6,933,000 \$1,213,000
- 2011 \$5,080,000 **\$ 3,066,000**
- 2012 \$4,712,000\$3,433,000
- 2013 \$5,299,000 <u>\$2,847,000</u> est.
- Cumulative Savings \$10,559,000



- Cumulative savings obtained 2010-2013
  - Energy management
  - "Shopping" for electricity
  - Energy efficiency projects



- Summary
  - Huge savings have already been realized
  - Well managed stable base to mitigate increasing costs
  - Current Procurement Objective Stabilize and control electrical costs for the next 3 years



- Strategy for 2013 RFP
  - Hired consultant Brakey Energy
  - Installed interval meters at target accounts
  - Identified 127 accounts and kWh usage



- RFP issued November 25, 2013
- 18 firms downloaded the solicitation from the website
- 6 firms submitted proposals



- Evaluation Panel Members:
  - Rail Equipment
  - Service Quality
  - Office of Management and Budget
  - Procurement
  - Legal



- Evaluation Criteria
  - Total Cost of Power
  - Terms of Contract
  - Financial Viability
  - Experience



- Due to the nature of the electricity market, suppliers can only hold pricing for a few days
- Best and final offers with revised pricing were received January 17, 2014, when a final recommendation was made
- Direct Energy Business, LLC provided a not to exceed price of \$0.05047/kWh
