Activities Since Last Update

- August 29, 2014 submitted all documentation of our ESMS program to Virginia Tech for review.
- September 29, 2014 EMT management review
- October 2, 2014 conducted emergency spill drill at CBMF, CAR's and PAR's being issued
- October 20, 2014 Virginia Tech performed onsite Gap Audit of ESMS, CAR's being issued



Decisions Since Last Update

- Bring revisions to Environmental Policy to Board for action
- EMT sign-off and approval of 17 ESMS procedures issued on October 1, 2014
- o ESMS program to go live on January 1, 2015
- Next phase of program will be to develop the ESMS for Hayden and Triskett Garage Facilities



Revisions to Environmental Policy

- Add "and other" to second bullet
- Change "Prevent' to "Prevention of" and "conserve" to "conservation of" in the fourth bullet
- Change "continuous" to "continual" in the sixth bullet.
- Punctuation change adding a "," in the fourth bullet and revising "policy" to "Policy" in concluding statement



Future Activities

- o Incorporate ISO 14001 into 2015 budgets
- Address Gap Audit Findings into ESMS
- Select independent ISO 14001 Registrar and Audit Team
- ESMS go live date January 1, 2015
- Trainer Final Audit February 23, 2015
- o ISO 14001 Certification Activities June 2015
