Architect/Engineering Services for E. 34th Street Station Design

- o Serves Blue, Green and Red Lines
- Light rail platform rebuilt in 1981 with stairway and canopy rebuilt in 1985
- Heavy rail (wood) platform built in 2005
- Design services from preliminary to plans thru construction assistance



Architect/Engineering Services for E. 34th Street Station Design

- New station will be ADA-compliant
- Station to have covered ramps, precast platform and new track
- At-grade westbound track crossing protected by gates and flashers from Brookpark
- Standardized signage, lighting and security systems



Architect/Engineering Services for E. 34th Street Station Design

- Construction budget \$5 million
- o 360-day design schedule
- o Construction start planned January 2017
- New station completion September 2018

- Received by 13 Potential Vendors
- o 5 Firms Submitted Proposals
- o 5 Firms Shortlisted
