Justification:

- RTA is federally mandated to provide laboratory drug testing for all safety sensitive employees.
- RTA also has safety and wellness policies that require possible non-federally required laboratory drug testing including nicotine testing.



Project Overview-Laboratory Drug Testing Services Scope of Work

- Provide laboratory drug screens in accordance with federal regulations for Department of Transportation (DOT) and non-DOT drug Screens.
- Approximately 2,600 screens a year.
- Three year contract with two, one-year options.



- o RFP issued May 11, 2015
- Accessed on the GCRTA website by 29 interested parties
- Two firms proposed
