## Introduction & Purpose

The Greater Cleveland Trails Leadership Network is a collaboration to facilitate *communication* and *drive the regional trail effort*, by raising the *visibility, prioritization, funding*, and *implementation* of relevant actions in order to complete the recreation, transportation-choice network.



### Digital Trail Inventory


