- Electricity major component of budget
 - 2016 budget \$6,725,000
 - Propulsion Power 52%
 - Facilities 48%



Budgeted Cost per Utility/Other

CEI (Direct Energy)

\$5,331,000 - 79.3%

• CPP (04/2020)

\$768,000 - 11.4%

Other (non-contracted)

\$626,000 - 9.3%

Total

\$6,725,000 - 100.0%



- History
 - Prior to deregulation Electricity sole sourced from Utility
 - June 2009 Ohio's Electric Market was opened for competition
 - Distribution Utility
 - Electricity Utility or Supplier



- Since deregulation, 3 Electricity Supply RFPs
 - Jan 10 to Jun 11 Price decrease from \$.069 to \$.053
 - Jun 11 to Jun 14 Price decrease from \$.053 to \$.049
 - Jun 14 to Jun 17 Slight price increase of \$.049 to \$.050

- Cumulative savings obtained 2010-2015
 - Energy management
 - "Shopping" for electricity
 - Energy efficiency projects
- Offset by
 - Utility price increases
 - Weather driven usage





- Current Electrical Supply Prices
 - Potentially as low as \$0.05
- Procurement Objective Stabilize and control electrical supply costs through June 2019



- RFP issued February 29, 2016
- Proposals Due March 30, 2016
- 19 interested parties downloaded the solicitation from the website
- 7 firms submitted proposals

- Due to the nature of the electricity market,
 suppliers can only hold pricing for a few days
- Currently in the evaluation process
- Best and final offers with revised pricing will be received April 25, 2016 when a final evaluation will take place



A recommendation with a not to exceed contract amount will be taken to the April 26, 2016 Board Meeting for approval
