- Update Service Management Activities
 - Codifies current practices of monitoring route performance
 - Clarifies annual Service Management Plan process





- Public Hearing Policy Update
 - Updates Public Notice Procedures
 - Removes procedures now handled by NOACA
 - Reorganizes for clarity



- Updates Public Notice Procedures
 - Retains newspaper notices
 - o Adds notices on RTA website
 - Clarifies that two week comment period does not apply for capital and operating budget





- Reorganizes for Clarity
 - Chapter 214 only defines public hearing processes including notice requirements
 - Policies governing which types of service changes require public hearing are moved to Service Code Section 1012.03
