This project seeks to secure cost effective mobile voice and data services, from a qualified wireless communications provider, to assist the Authority in delivering worldclass public transportation services.



Scope of Work:

- Mobile voice and data services for smartphone users
 - 30 Apple iPhone and Samsung Galaxy Devices
- Mobile voice services for feature phones
 - 45 Ruggedized Kyocera "Flip phones"



Scope of Work, continued:

- Mobile data for various non-revenue vehicles
 - 66 mobile data routers
- Mobile data for tablets
 - Approximately 12 iPads and Samsung Galaxy tablets
- Mobile data for other devices
 - Modems and mobile "hotspots"



Service Features:

- Unlimited calling minutes
- Nationwide long distance
- o Unlimited text
- Unlimited data for smartphones and tablets
- Pooled data for mobile data routers
- Wide selection of discounted devices
