## **Bus Stop Safety & Consolidation**

- Completed Routes 1, 3, 5, 9, 10, 14, 22, 25, 26, 28, 32, 41, 48, 51, 53F, 55, and 86
- Scheduled implementation with June 3, 2018 Service
   Change:
  - #30: E 140 Lakeshore (including part of #39 Lakeshore)
  - #49: Center Ridge Road
  - #81: Tremont Storer



**Bus Stop Safety & Consolidation** 

- Upgrade bus stops to new design
  - o Route number
  - Destination
  - Days/hours of service
  - Stop ID number
- Consolidate nearby stops to provide faster service to residents and businesses on the route
- Improve safety of bus stops throughout RTA network



# Paratransit-Lyft Pilot Program

- Supplemental Paratransit Service provided by Lyft through their app. Rider pays Paratransit fare (\$2.75), RTA subsidy up to \$12. Rider pays any cost over \$14.75.
- More flexibility and control for our ADA customers.
- Cost savings means RTA can provide more service.
- 65 participants; estimated 6-month program duration.
- For FTA compliance, participants must book their initial trip
   24 hours in advance.



# Review of March 11 Improvements

- Better Job Connectivity
  - #5- new alignment to serve UH Ahuja Hospital, Harvard Park, Tri-C East, Pinecrest, other jobs on Orange Place
  - #15- streamlined service to/from Tri-C East
  - #19- better service to Amazon Fulfillment Center and more convenient transfers to job sites along #41

- Most changes are minor adjustments
- New timetables effective June 3 for: HealthLine, Red Line, Blue/Green Line, 2, 7, 9, 14, 15, 22, 25, 26, 41/41F, 45, 48/48A, 49, 51/A/B/C (MetroHealth Line), 55/A/B/C (Cleveland State Line), 76, 79/79A, 90F
- Weekday daytime HealthLine to run every 10 min.
- All Detroit-Superior Bridge trips extend to E. 3




## Improve Temporary Rail Replacement Bus

Speed up #66R & #67R service to increase ridership


 Many adjustments have been tested through planned shutdowns

Improve information signs at all stations

















#### When Train Service is Suspended




# #51 Late Night Movement- Current

North via State




# Potential Future Service Change Ideas

#### #14 & #15 to use Superior Bus Lanes?


- Average travel time is similar on both alternatives
- Travel time via Superior is much more reliable
- Prospect subject to larger delay fluctuations due to special events downtown
- Origin & Destination Survey data indicated that many riders would be better served by the proposed route


## #14/#15 Alternatives
