#### Current CAB operating guidelines

- 1. Organization is currently known as the GCRTA Citizens Advisory Board (CAB)
- 2. Currently there is designation in place to honor long standing members for their service to the CAB, GCRTA, and the community.
- 3. The whole of the CAB currently meets on a monthly basis, as well as their subcommittees



#### Current CAB operating guidelines

- 4. Current terms limits for the CAB, are to not serve more than two consecutive 3 years terms for a total of 6 years in a row.
- 5. There are 20 members of the CAB, 10 are appointed by the Board of Trustees of the GCRTA and the other 10 are appointed by a slate based on applications from the public and approval by a committee of the CAB and RTA staff.



### Proposed changes to the CAB

- 1. The Citizens Advisory Board (CAB) will now be known as the Community Advisory Committee (CAC).
- 2. The five long standing members of the CAC who have served more than 15 years consecutively have been recognized with emeritus status and will no longer occupy roster seats on the CAC
- 3. The CAC will meet at a minimum on a quarterly basis (more meetings can be added as needed). CAC committees will also meet at a minimum on a quarterly basis.



#### Proposed changes to the CAB

- 4. Term limits for the CAC will now be instituted and will be adhered to. No member may serve more than two consecutive three year terms. Terms will be staggered to ensure that more seven members turnover at once.
- 5. All member of the CAC will be appointed by the Board of Trustees.

At the June 19, 2018 a resolution will be offered proposing to streamline the code provision and adopt a new set of operating guidelines.
