What Service Is Provided?

- Transport ADA clients with certified disabilities
- Supplemental to fixed route service (FTA)
- Additional service 5 miles
- Services provided on a 24/7 basis within Cuyahoga County.
- In-house and contracted personnel.





Provision of Paratransit Services

- o RTA books on average 2,381 daily trips
- Paratransit currently completes 1,581 trips per day
 - o RTA 700 **(44.3%)**
 - o Provide-A-Ride 448 **(28.3%)**
 - o Lakefront 339 **(21.4%)**
 - Senior Transportation Connection 94 (5.9%)
- o RTA (44.3%) Contractors (55.7%)





Service Provision Challenges

- o "No Denial" Policy. 7,101,484 requests
- o Paratransit capacity constraint (400,000 trips).
- Significant cancellation rate (26%).
- Substantial increase in trips over the years
- Fiduciary responsibility to be cost effective.

Contract Extension

- o A four month extension will:
 - Allow all Paratransit purchased transportation contracts to end simultaneously with the goal of attracting a larger and national pool of potential proposers on new RFP which was issued and is due September 27, 2018
 - Allow the Lakefront Lines, Inc. provided service to continue without interruption and continue to meet the daily demands of customers



Recommendation

Staff requests that the Operational, Planning & Infrastructure Committee recommend to the Board of Trustees a four month extension to the current contract, at the same negotiated rates, with Lakefront Lines, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,050,055.00.
